

## GRAND TARGHEE BLUEGRASS CAMP FAQ's

### How will the Camp be structured?

### What does it cost?

The basic tuition for Grand Targhee Bluegrass Camp (which includes tuition, meals and lodging) is \$750. This price is based on sharing a room with one other student. For students wishing a single room, or to share a room with a spouse or non-student guest, see prices below. ### **When are full payments due? Can I get a refund?**

Full payment for Camp is due upon time of your registration.

Refunds: Refunds are available, less a \$50 registration fee, prior to July 1.

Beginning July 1, there are no refunds, however your fee can be applied to next year's camp.

### **What about ability levels?**

The classes will be geared towards intermediate and advanced players, so some degree of proficiency is expected. There are no beginner classes so please do not sign up for a class if you have never played the instrument! You should be able to strum, pick or bow basic chords in time, play simple melodies and be comfortable with slow jamming. Classes may be divided by ability depending on how many participants we have. Students are discouraged from switching classes.

### **Can I bring friends or family along to the Camp?**

Yes, see pricing above.

### **Are children welcome?**

Grand Targhee Bluegrass Camp welcomes students of all ages, however students 17 and younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

### **Can I bring my dog?**

No

### **Can I bring my RV?**

Yes, there is RV parking (see rates above). No hook-ups for power or water. Must be self contained. (RV campers do have access to pool, hot tub, fitness room & shower).

### **Is there camping at Targhee during Bluegrass Camp?**

No. However Teton Canyon is an excellent USFS campground just a few miles down the road.

### **Will meals be served?**

Hearty meals will be provided by the Targhee kitchen as follows: breakfast (W,Th, F), lunch (T, W, Th, F) and dinner (T, W, Th). There are several on-site restaurants available for students arriving early. Note: Breakfast is only offered to the students staying up at Targhee.

**How do I get to Grand Targhee?**

Grand Targhee is located just outside of Driggs, ID. The closest airports are Jackson, WY (45 miles) and Idaho Falls, ID (84 miles). From Driggs, follow Ski Hill Rd / Little Avenue east for about 6 blocks. You will reach a fork. Bear left and the road becomes Ski Hill Road.

Remain on Ski Hill Road through Alta, Wy and on up the hill. Ski Hill Road ends at Grand Targhee Resort! For more info visit: [www.grandtarghee.com](http://www.grandtarghee.com) or call 1-800-TARGHEE.

**If I register for Grand Targhee Bluegrass Camp, can I stay in my room for the Grand Targhee Bluegrass Festival?**

**What can I buy at Targhee?**

The General Store has most of the essentials, snacks, toiletries, beer & wine. There is also a coffee shop.

**What can I buy in Driggs?**

Driggs is the closest town. Here you will find a post office, a music store, a health food store, grocery, a pharmacy, 1/2 dozen restaurants, bakery, drive thru coffee, several gas stations, banks, etc.

**What should I bring with me?**

Targhee is at 8000' so expect mountain weather - anything from 80's to 30's at night. Classrooms are indoors, so you don't need anything out of the ordinary for camp, but you may want to have warm clothes & rain gear to take advantage of your surroundings. Don't forget shorts, a swimming suit, sunscreen, hiking boots or a mountain bike. Also bring picks, rosin, extra strings, tuner, watch, recording device, notebook and extra batteries.

**Will my cell phone and laptop internet work?**

yes and no....there is some cell service at the resort. Edge wireless works. Other are hit and miss. There is complimentary high-speed wireless internet access.
